How to enter

1. Carefully read the rules, terms and conditions overleaf.
2. Register by emailing the following details to jgiles@regensw.co.uk by Friday 17th April:
 - Name of entrant
 - Contact number and email address
 - Name of your baked dish
 - List of main ingredients (including allergens)
 - If using local ingredients, where they are from

All entrants must register
and bake prior to the event



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Entry rules, terms and conditions

1. You must register beforehand

Registration to enter the Renewable Energy Bake Off will close at midday on Friday 17 April 2015. There is a strict limit on numbers so please get your entry in A.S.A.P!

We won't be able to accept any new entries on the day of the competition.

There is only one way of registering: you can register by emailing Jodie Giles at jgiles@regensw.co.uk. All the details requested (overleaf) must be completed.

- You need to be aged 16 or over to enter the Renewable Energy Bake Off.
- Once you've registered we'll email you 2 Renewable Energy Marketplace tickets which you will need to print off. Please bring in your tickets on 21 April – see below.
- By entering this competition, all participants agree to be bound by these terms and conditions.

2. Bake

- You need to supply one renewable energy inspired bake.
- It needs to be your own work! All ingredients must be fresh and your bakes must be made by hand, including pastry.
- No restrictions on recipes but all items must be baked and ideally include at least one local ingredient.
- We will be unable to re-heat any bakes – so they should be designed to be eaten cold.
- Our judges will mark your bakes on visual impact, taste and connection to the renewable energy theme.
- Photos of all entries and details of all recipes will be shared online
- The winners will be required to accept their prizes and be photographed by the press.
- All recipes must be submitted in advance and must be available for publication by Regen SW, organisers of the Renewable Energy Bake Off (entrants will be credited if published).
- Your bakes should be baked no earlier than 20 April.
- On the day, we will give you a registration number for your bake.

3. Bring in your bake on 21 April

- Once your bake is ready and cooled, put them in the fridge but don't freeze them.
- Place them in a suitable container (lunch-box, take-away box, biscuit tin) that will retain the shape of your bake.
- On Tuesday 21 April, bring your bakes along with your ticket/s to Westpoint between 9am and 10am. Due to the expected high volumes of entrants arriving on the day we'd appreciate it if you could arrive as early as you can – our site will open for parking from 8:30am that day. **Any entrants arriving later than 10am could be disqualified from the competition.**
- When you arrive go straight to the reception at Westpoint's main entrance and present your competition ticket. You'll then be directed to the Bake Off display area where you sign in for the event and leave your bakes for judging. Please note that we won't have facilities for storing cold boxes and containers on the day. You will need to provide the plate or container for your display.
- There will be a programme confirming when the announcements will be made.

Judging

- The bakes will be judged by a panel of expert judges.
- As soon as registration starts, no correspondence with the judges can be entered into.
- The judges' verdict is final!

What next

After the competition, you can collect your display plate or container with the remainder of your bake, unless you would like to share it with the lovely people at Renewable Energy Marketplace!



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
