## Green firms exhibit at fair

**N**ORTH Devon's green businesses will be exhibiting at the 361 Energy Fair in Barnstaple Pannier Market on November 6. The fair is organised by 361 Energy, the not-for-profit social enterprise that promotes energy saving and renewable energy in North Devon.

This free and unique event will feature the latest electric vehicles, environmental groups and a range of family activities plus 25 exhibitors offering renewable and energy-saving technologies.
